The Sustainable Marshfield Committee is beginning a new citizen river monitoring program, with cooperation from the Department of Natural Resources and University of Wisconsin-Extension's Water Action Volunteers Program, Marshfield Utilities and Groundwater Guardians. The project will provide important information and allow local people to learn more about selected wadable streams in the Marshfield Area.

Volunteers will be trained in 6 measurement techniques to assess the quality of a local stream or river. For this training, we will check the Yellow River in nearby Weber Park. Next spring, those who wish to continue in the project will meet to decide which streams we'd like to monitor for 2010. There is no charge for the training. Space is limited and advance registration is required. Further information will be sent to registrants ahead of the session.
